
## Mission

## Message From the Chair of the Board and President & CEO

The Lenawee Community Foundation exists to serve individuals, businesses, communities, and organizations in achieving their charitable goals for our community. Contrary to what one might think, you can often achieve your charitable goals with little or no impact on the inheritance for your heirs. Giving does not need to be complicated, nor does it require great wealth.

Over the 2010-2011 fiscal year, generous donors invested \$1.8 million in the Lenawee Community Foundation to support education, health, civic projects, culture, and social services. To benefit our county the Lenawee Community Foundation achieved the following:

- Grants and scholarships exceeding \$1.7 million were awarded -- more than any other nongovernmental organization.
- Operating expenses were reduced over the prior year with 94% of our income going to programs.
- Stewardship was fundamental with national standards recertification achieved, and a capable, committed Board of Directors assuring sound financial and investment policies and procedures. Professional investment managers met benchmarks, and an annual audit reported a clean opinion.
- Volunteerism was enhanced through a volunteer generation grant for VOLUNTEER Lenawee! and a full-time AmeriCorps\*VISTA volunteer.
- Foundation initiatives strengthened our community. The Imagination Library delivered over 18,000 books to children ages zero to five. The Lenawee Youth Council & Youth Leadership taught philanthropy to our youth and encouraged them to volunteer. Hunters Helping Lenawee donated over 1,200 pounds of venison to local food pantries. Additionally, the Health Across Lenawee program was initiated to build a healthier community.

While we are pleased with current achievements, the best is yet to come. The Lenawee Community Foundation is the **only** local nonprofit to focus primarily on the future. Most gifts are invested to last permanently - like a community savings account - with grants made annually from the earnings.

The Lenawee Community Foundation works with donors from all walks of life, who share our wishes that Lenawee will continue to be a great place to live, work and raise our families. 
# Funds within the Lenawee Community Foundation

Existing funds may be utilized for gifts, or donors may establish new funds in the Lenawee Community Foundation. Funds are categorized in seven areas: Lenawee, Lenawee Leadership, Field of Interest, Donor Advised, Designated, Lenawee Community Projects and Scholarships.

There are several ways to establish funds to meet the charitable interests and financial circumstances of individuals, businesses and organizations. A commitment of \$10,000 is required to establish a fund, however gifts in any amount are accepted for existing funds.

*A named fund can be established in your name, a business or organization name, the name of a person you wish to honor, or the name of a person for whom you wish to create a lasting memory.*

# Funds within the Lenawee Community Foundation (continued)

## Lenawee Fund

The Lenawee Fund is a multi-purpose, flexible endowed fund to meet current and emerging needs. Donors may choose the Lenawee Fund if they believe that a group of living individuals will always be better able to assess current situations than a document from the past. This fund is designed to meet emerging community needs, respond to change, create innovative approaches and enhance the quality of life in Lenawee County. After the Lenawee Community Foundation Board of Directors evaluates all aspects of community well-being, grants are given by the Lenawee Community Foundation Board to areas of greatest need.

## Lenawee Leadership Fund

This non-endowed fund has been established to provide support for current community needs or support for the Lenawee Community Foundation's administration or leadership role in the Lenawee County community. Disbursements are made by the Community Foundation Board.

## Field of Interest Funds

A Field of Interest Fund allows a donor to support a broad area, such as health, youth, the arts, services to seniors, economic development or whatever charitable issue the donor chooses. Donors may also support their home community, where local advisory committees make recommendations for grants. A personal interest area is identified when the gift is made, and then the Lenawee Community Foundation Board of Directors makes grants to community agencies and programs that are making a difference in the area that has been selected.

The donor's suggestions must be reviewed and approved by the Community Foundation Board. A Donor Advised Fund acts much like a private foundation, however it is easier to establish, less expensive to operate and less restrictive in distributions, payouts and investments.





One in every seven American households is “food insecure” - not sure where they’ll get their next meal - and Lenawee County is no exception. Over 9,000 children meet income qualifications for free or reduced lunches. Over 1,000 individuals are served by our local food pantries monthly, and about half are children, who especially need protein for healthy growth and development. One deer provides meat on the average for one meal for 200 people!

We are grateful to the hunters who donated their field-dressed, tagged, legally harvested deer at Jerome Market for processing and to the donors who contributed to Hunters Helping Lenawee to cover the processing costs. Because of generous and caring people, our local food pantries received meat for over 4,000 meals for people in need.
